1. Welcome/Introduction/ground rules/aims

- Thanks, introduce self, re-state purpose of the interview, structure, length (about 10 mins)
- Discussion of how interview will be recorded and transcribed, right to withdrawal, issues of confidentiality, anonymisation and informed consent. – if agree start audio recorder
- Verbal consent
 - 1. You agree to our conversation being audio recorded?
 - 2. You know you are free to stop the interview at any point and you may skip questions you would prefer not to answer?
 - 3. You understand that quotations from the interview may be used to illustrate our findings but it will not be possible to trace who said them?

2. Reasons for declining

- Why did you decide not to take part in the TRIUMPH study?
- Were they any other reasons?
- Did you discuss your decision with others? If not, did you want to?
- Have you taken part in a research study before? If so, what were your experiences of doing so?

3. Approach and information received

- How did you hear about the study?
- What did you think of the study information?
- What was your understanding of the aims of the study?
- What was your understanding of what taking part in the study would have involved?
 - Randomisation, equipoise, arms
- How did you feel about being asked to take part in a study?

4. Suggestions

- Is there anything that could be changed about the study that might have made you more interested in taking part?
- Can you think of anything that we can do to encourage people to take part in the study?

5. Background information

- Age, family situation
- Did you come to the GP specifically about your LUTS?

6. Closing

- Thank them for their time.
- Any other issues the participant would like to raise?
