- My only comment would be that the presentation & work stream on 'Organisational Change' was unnecessarily overly academic in tone. I consider myself well educated but the concepts were beyond those of us in the group, I struggled to see the application of the academic to the practical assistance/information I was hoping for.

- Only one talk not as good as the rest 'Understanding clinical activities' as did not provide many insights into end user behaviour adaptation.
