Verbatim extract of author's analytic interpretation of results or data <sup>1</sup> May be a theme/subtheme/concept	An illustrative excerpt presented by the researcher in support of the particular finding, e.g., direct quotation, fieldwork observations, other supporting data	Assigned to each finding Unequivocal – finding accompanied by illustration that is beyond reasonable doubt Credible – finding accompanied by illustration lacking clear association; could be open to challenge Not supported – finding not supported by the data; not included in synthesis to inform practice
